### RULES AND INFORMATION

Class number for Steer is Class #16

1. Sale will be held at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday at the fair.
2. All market steers and heifers to be sold must be weighed and identified at weigh-in date scheduled by the livestock committee.
3. In the event an ear tag is lost, the exhibitor should immediately contact the Extension Office. A member of the livestock committee will retag the animal within a reasonable amount of time.
4. Market steers must be dehorned and castrated at time of tagging.
5. Market steers and heifers must be owned by the exhibitor and must be carried as a project either in 4-H or Agricultural Education. It at all possible, market steers and heifers must be fed on exhibitor's premises.
6. Must be tied in stall with rope halter and neck rope.
7. Records on the market steer or heifer are to be presented by the exhibitor when called for by the committee. To be eligible to show and sell a market steer or heifer, the exhibitor must live in Gasconade County or be a member of a 4-H Club or FFA Chapter within Gasconade County.
8. A 4-H or FFA Member may weigh and identify **two** market steers or heifers, may show **two** market steers or heifers in the market steer and heifer show; but will only be allowed to sell **one**. **The highest placed animal will sell.**
9. Market steers and heifers will be weighed when arriving at the fair and this weight will be posted above the market steer or heifer in its stall and used as selling weight. Market steers and heifers **must weigh at least 1000 lbs. at Fair.**
10. The market steer and heifer show will be held on Thursday evening, July 25th, at 7 p.m.
11. Sale order - sell according to placing.
12. Market steers and heifers will be placed by judge who judges the other beef classes at the fair.
13. Entry fee is \$8.00 to be submitted with entry form.
14. A rate of gain class will be included.
15. Selling fee is \$15.00 per head.
16. There will be a Market Steer and Heifer Showmanship Class following the Market Steer and Heifer Show. To keep with MCCA show requirements we will have a MCCA steer show and market heifer show after the breeding cattle show on Friday. This will be open to any steers or market heifers that show on Thursday at the in county show plus any junior steers or market heifers from out of county. Thursday show and Saturday sale will still only be in county steers and market heifers only. Friday market show will be for ribbon and MCCA points only and will be blow and go (no adhesives). If you will Steer Showmanship on Thursday and are a MCCA member you may compete again on Friday for MCCA showmanship but for points only, if you would win again awards would go to the next placing showman, but points would be reported to MCCA.
17. **All generator uses shall be approved by Livestock Committee.**
