Class number for Market Lamb or Goat: **In county** 4-H or FFA is **1A**  
**Out of County** 4-H or FFA is **1B**

1. Weigh-In is the first Saturday of May from 8am-9am. (subject to change if conflict) Location at the Gasconade County Fair Grounds-Dairy Barn. A clinic with your animal will follow from 9am-11am for those that wish to participate.
2. Scrapies Tag must be attached to animal's ear. 4-H/FFA member may weigh-in up to 4 animals buy only show 2. Animals to be eligible for sale must be weighed in. If animal is not weighed in they can show in the Open Market Class.
3. Animal's weight will be recorded and kept by committee as official beginning weight. The percentage of Rate of Gain will be calculated on the Thursday of the Fair and the best rate will be awarded the Rate of Gain.
4. **A market lamb or goat may be a female or wether.**
5. WEIGHT AT FAIR TIME: 100 lbs. minimum for lamb and 55lbs. for goats. If lamb or goat does not reach weight at time of weigh-in they can show in the market class but is not eligible to sell at the sale.
6. To be eligible to sell a lamb or goat, the exhibitor must live in Gasconade County, or be a member of a FFA Chapter or 4-H Club within Gasconade County, and their entry form has been signed by their Chapter advisor or 4-H Leader.
7. Lambs and Goats must be owned and carried as 4-H or FFA project by, the exhibitor.
8. There is a \$15.00 per head selling fee.
9. Class placing will set the sale order and if and exhibitor shows 2 animals, the highest placing animal will sell.
10. The Sheep and Goat sale will follow the Barrow sale on Saturday.
11. Market Animals must be owned 60 days prior to the fair and breeding stock owned 30 days prior to the fair.
12. Entry Deadline is **July 1, 2020**
