

Farm Class Tractor Pull

Field Class will start IMMEDIATELY after MMTTPA

Farm Pull Rules and Regulations 2018

1. Contest will be limited to field class tractors only. NO tire chains, rear duals, or four-wheel drives allowed. NO hand-cut or hand sharpened tires allowed.
2. **Entry Fee \$20.00 per hook.**
3. ALL TRACTORS MAY ENTER ONLY 1 CLASS.

Classes:

- a. **5,501-7,500* - 16.9x38 tire size** - 5 mph**
- b. **7,501-9,500* - 18.4x38 tire size** - 5 mph**
- c. **9,501-11,500* - 20.8x38 tire size ** - 6 mph**
- d. **11,501-13,500* - 20.8x42 tire size** - 6 mph**

*Weight of tractor includes driver.

**Tires must be proper size or the equivalent. Formula to determine equivalent:
(width x 2) + diameter.

4. Drawbar height limit will be 21 inches. Minimum length of drawbar will be 20 inches from center of rear axle. All tractors must use clevis with 3-inch opening or hitch with 3-inch opening allowing hook to swing free.
5. Rear tractor weights cannot interfere with hooking of sled. Three pt. weights must be turned so the heaviest side is to the inside of tractor-not sled.
6. FUEL: One fuel only – Gas, LP or Diesel.
7. **Max 3,000 RPM limit.**
8. Removal of items such as hoods and other items which create a safety hazard will not be allowed. All tractors must use two front wheels.
9. All weights must be bolted or securely fastened to the tractor. Any loss of weights will result in disqualification. Any front-end weight cannot extend more than 24 inches in front of the factory hood on the tractor.
10. **Contestants UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE must have written consent of parent or guardian. Parent and participant must sign provided form day of event.**
11. The maximum speed will be recorded by the pulling sled. If the maximum speed is exceeded during the pull, a horn will sound from the sled. Each puller has from the start of the pull to the 100-ft. mark to set their speed. If the puller exceeds the maximum speed past the 100-ft. mark, the puller is then disqualified.
12. **No person will be allowed in the area other than tractor operators and contest officials.**

13. The pull is ended when:

- a. Forward motion of tractor stops,**
- b. Driver does not remain seated,**
- c. Tractor or sled does not stay within the pulling strip or tractor hitch breaks,**
- d. If track official waves red flag, participant will stop.**

14. If a puller is not ready when his turn comes, he can forfeit his turn and pull last in that class.

15. Unsportsmanlike conduct before, during or after tractor pull will mean disqualification, also forfeiture of entry fee plus prize money won.

16. First puller of each class has the option of repulling. If repulling, you must tell judges before unhooking from the sled. Last pull is measured. If sled is not readjusted before the fourth tractor pulls in each class, class will be official.

17. Tractors will be weighed immediately before pulling.

18. Caution should be exercised at all times. Failure to comply with safety procedures may result in disqualification.

19. All disabled tractors must be removed from the track prior to the next tractor pulling. The committee will use whatever means deemed necessary to remove the tractor.

20. Protests can only be made by a contestant in the same weight class. All protests must be made before the next class starts or 5 minutes after the last tractor in the last class is finished. Pull is official unless the tractor is checked and found to be out of compliance. The driver that makes the protest will be checked for the same infraction.

21. ALL field Class tractors must be removed from the grounds after all Field classes are finished.

22. Tractor Driver and one other person will not have to pay entry onto fairgrounds as long as they accompany the tractor.

23. The Tractor Pull Committee will have final decision on all questions, disputes, hardship cases, etc., that may develop.
