All animals (except castrated males) must have an official USDA Scrapie Tag. It is encouraged that Market goats to weigh at least 60 pounds at fair date.

Age divisions for showmanship: Juniors 8-11 yrs.; Intermediate 12-16 yrs.; Seniors – 17-21 yrs. (4-H and FFA)

PeeWee Class – Youth ages 4-7 years old. This class is open to any youngster to either show a sheep or goat. Exhibition ONLY for the fun and experience.

12. Dairy Herd – 4 does (1 doe – 4 years older or older in milk, 1 doe – 2 years old or older in
