Class number for 4-H & FFA Market Barrow and Gilt is **Class #1**

1. Live score and ultrasound formula will determine final index.
2. Records on the barrows and gilts are to be presented by the exhibitor when called for by the livestock committee. To be eligible to show and sell a barrow or gilt, the exhibitor must live in Gasconade County or be a member of a 4-H or FFA Chapter within Gasconade County.
3. An exhibitor will be allowed to weigh-in 2 pigs to feed out. **No alternate pigs will be allowed.** Pigs will be identified by ear tags. Both barrows and gilts will be allowed; however a member will be allowed to show two barrows or gilts, but sell only one, unless the member has both grand and reserve champion. **Only two animals may be brought to the fair for Class #1.**
4. The committee reserves the right to divide the barrows and gilts into classes according to weight.
5. Each pig must be registered under an exhibitor's name. No alternate pigs will be allowed.
6. Pigs **CAN NOT** weigh more than 85 **pounds at weigh-in.**
7. Barrows and gilts will be weighed and ultra-sounded at the Fair at 7 p.m. on Wednesday and will not be allowed on the fairgrounds until after 2 p.m. on Wednesday. This will be the selling weight. Barrows and gilts must weigh at least 220 lbs. to show. Any animal weighing over 300 pounds will be allowed to exhibit and sell; **but at time of sale will only be allowed a maximum sale weight allotment of 300 pounds.**
8. The barrow and gilt show will be at 9 a.m. on Thursday. **Gilts will not be allowed to show in the breeding show.**
9. The sale will be on Saturday.
10. Barrows and gilts will be judged on the Danish System and will be placed according to the final index score. Sale order will be determined by placing.
11. Entry fees will be \$4.00 per head. The cost for the Sonogram equipment will be \$5.50 per barrow or gilt.
12. Selling fee is \$15.00 per head.
13. All barrows and gilts must be entered on Fair Livestock Entry forms with animal fees, sonogram, and selling fees enclosed. The committee normally pens the swine at a rate of one or two per half pen, three or four per whole pen.
14. No water pans allowed – pigs must use a nipple-type waterer.
15. **All exhibitors must supply their own shavings for their pens.**
