Class number for Market Wether is Class # 1

1. Market lamb and market goat must be a wether.
2. Lambs and goats will be weighed on **May 6, 2017 between 8:30 and 9:30 am at the fairgrounds.**
3. A lamb, to be eligible to show, must have a complete set of baby teeth with no sign of permanent teeth.
4. Weight – 100 lbs. minimum for lambs and 60 to 90 lbs. minimum for goats.
5. To be eligible to sell a lamb or goat, the exhibitor must live in Gasconade County or be a member of a FFA chapter or a 4-H Club within Gasconade County.
6. Lambs and goats must be owned and carried as a 4-H or FFA project by the exhibitor.
7. Selling fee is \$15.00 per head.
8. Class placing will set the sale order.
9. The sale will follow the barrow sale on Saturday.
10. Entries must be in the Extension Office by **July 1, 2017.**
