Junior, Intermediate, Senior and Open Showmanship

All breeds recognized by a breed association will be eligible to show; as well as unregistered crossbred animals (Jr. Show only). Open Show entries must be registered in their respective association and papers provided upon request. All animals (except **Market animals) must have an official USDA Scrapie Tag. No health papers required, veterinarian will inspect animals as they enter/arrive at fair. Exhibitors will be allowed to show two breeds of sheep and two per class (group classes limited to 1 group). Only blue ribbon animals in the Jr. Show will be eligible to show in the Open Show.**

Age divisions: Junior – 8 – 11; Intermediate – 12 – 16; Senior – 17 – 18 (for 4-H) or 21 (for FFA)

PeeWee Class – Youth ages 4-7 years old. This class is open to any youngster to either show a sheep or goat. Exhibition ONLY for the fun and experience.

Exhibitors must provide their own bedding for the Sheep and Goat Barn.

All animals are required to stay in the Sheep and Goat barn the morning of July 28th prior to the show.

Lee Freeman Memorial Herdsman Award is awarded to one exhibitor in the Sheep and Goat Barn who exhibits throughout the fair: 1) Good public relations with the fair-going community. 2) The care of

their animals and presentation and 3) Exhibiting and Showmanship on show day. The judging is made up of a committee. Recipient will be named at the awards presentation before the sale on Saturday.

Exhibitors are encouraged to decorate or make pen area appealing to the fair—going public.
Recognition of your farm/4-H Club/ FFA organizations are encouraged.
