

SOUTH CENTRAL MISSOURI DISTRICT FFA SHOW

SUPERINTENDENT: Nancy Alford

1. This division is open to anyone in South Central District and other FFA members that have not and will not show in other district shows, who is under 21 years of age and is regularly enrolled in Vocational Agriculture; or is an active FFA member who is under 21 years of age and has been out of high school less than 3 years or is Junior Project Member who is in the 7th and 8th grade, and was listed on the Preliminary Report of Supervised Farming.
2. All animals must be the property of the exhibitor at least 60 days prior to showing, and must be a part of his supervised farming program. Registration papers MUST be presented showing exhibitor's name as owner.
3. All entries MUST be approved and signed by his Vocational Agriculture Instructor.
4. To be eligible for competition the animals must be registered or eligible to register. Young animals up to six (6) months of age that are eligible to be registered will be accepted if the dam and sire are registered. Evidence of eligibility must be presented.
5. Not over two premiums will be awarded in any one class to any one exhibitor and only one premium in any one group class to any one exhibitor.
6. Vocational agriculture students must accompany, care for, and show their own animals. In case of any condition making the above impossible, another student from the same department may act. Under no conditions will parents, breeders, or other adults be permitted to show animals or aid in the showing of animals in this division.
7. All animals entered will meet the health requirements as stated in the open classes or general show regulations.
8. All judging will be done according to the Danish System, all premiums will be based on points allotted as follows:

	Gold	Silver	Bronze
Dairy and Beef Animals	40	30	20
Sheep and Hogs	20	15	10

In no case shall a point be worth more than 50 cents.

9. All gold and silver ribbon winners will be entered in the open classes. Registration papers must be available and shown upon request during open class showing. For animals under 6 months of age, sire and dam registration papers are sufficient.
10. All classes to be the same as the open classes unless stated otherwise at bottom of class listing. The same numbers shall be used but the letters FFA will follow the division designation.
11. All rules for adult livestock show must be adhered to in the South Central District FFA Show.
