RULES FOR 2025 4-H AND FFA REPLACEMENT HEIFER SHOW AND SALE

RULES AND INFORMATION

1. Replacement exhibitors must be 4-H or FFA members within Gasconade County and at least 8 years old as of January 1st of the current year.

2. Exhibitors can register two replacement heifers, but only show and sell one.

3. Replacement heifers must be born between January 1st and December 31st of 2024.

4. Replacement heifers will be shown by birth date.

5. No horns or scurs allowed. Must be polled or dehorned and completely healed prior to the fair.

6. Must be vaccinated for IBR, BVD, PI3, BRSV, Lepto (5-Way), Vibriosis, 7-Way Clostridia, and BVD-PI test must be negative.

7. Must be treated for internal and external parasites within 30 days of the fair.

8. Must present a CVI form from a veterinarian with information regarding health status, required vaccinations, and parasite control, along with pregnancy status, pelvic measurements, and reproductive tract score if over 1 year of age by the Fair. Must have an EID tag.

9. Entry submission is required for replacement heifers and are due July 1st. See entries details.

10. Exhibitors can show market animals of other species as well, they will be allowed to sell one market animal and one replacement heifer, then the exhibitor will collect all the proceeds of their market animal along with 80% of the replacement heifer proceeds and 20% of the proceeds will go back to the livestock committee for improvements.

11. Replacement heifers will sell last in the livestock sale

auction. Sale order will be determined by class placing. 12. The replacement heifer show will be held on Thursday evening, at 6:30 p.m.

ENTRIES:

a. All entries will be submitted by going to http://gasconadecounty.fairentry.com/; by logging in through your 4HOnline family profile or creating a Fair Entry profile if FFA or breeder. Registrations for livestock classes will run from May 15 - July 1. Please register early! Contact the Extension Office at 573-266-2701 if you need assistance. NO LATE REGISTRATIONS FOR LIVESTOCK WILL BE ACCEPTED.

b. All entry fees, selling fees will be paid by credit/debit card online or check/M.O. mailed to the Gasconade County Fair Assn, P.O. Box 15, Owensville, MO 65066 by July 7, of the current year.

c. Livestock Exhibitors must purchase their Season Passes at a participating local business.

d. To be eligible to show and sell a market animal, the exhibitor must live in Gasconade County or be a member of a 4-H Community Club or FFA Chapter within Gasconade County.
