RULES AND INFORMATION

Class number for Market Steer & Heifer is **Class #16**

1. Sale will be held at **3:00 p.m.** on Saturday at the fair.
2. All market steers and heifers to be sold must be weighed and identified at weigh-in date scheduled by the livestock committee. In the event an ear tag is lost, the exhibitor should immediately contact the Extension Office. A member of the livestock committee will retag the animal within a reasonable amount of time.
3. Market steers must be dehorned and castrated at time of tagging.
4. Market steers and heifers must be owned by the exhibitor and must be carried as a project either in 4-H or Agricultural Education. If at all possible, market steers and heifers must be fed on exhibitor's premises.
5. Must be tied in stall with rope halter and neck rope.
6. Records on the market steer or heifer are to be presented by the exhibitor when called for by the committee.
7. A 4-H or FFA Member may weigh and identify **2** market steers or heifers, may show **2** market steers or heifers in the market steer and heifer show; but will only be allowed to sell **1**. **"Highest placing animal will sell at Auction."**
8. Market steers and heifers will be weighed when arriving at the fair and this weight will be posted above the market steer or heifer in its stall and used as selling weight. Market

steers and heifers **must weigh at least 1000 lbs. at Fair.**

9. The market steer and heifer show will be held on Thursday evening, at 7:00 p.m.
10. Sale order - sell according to placing.
11. Entry fee is \$8.00.
12. A rate of gain class will be included.
13. Selling fee is \$25.00 per head.
14. There will be a Market Steer and Heifer Showmanship Class following the Market Steer and Heifer Show.
15. **All generator uses shall be approved by Livestock Committee.**
16. All beef require an active CVI form for the duration of the fair and an EID tag as stated in the General Livestock Rules.

RULES FOR 2026 4-H AND FFA REPLACEMENT HEIFER SHOW AND SALE

Chair: Dylan Fries

Thank you to the 2025 sponsors of TROPHIES - Wright Brick & Block, United Mutual Insurance - Steve Nolte. PLAQUES - Crown Power & Equipment, KVK Land & Cattle, Scheer Cattle Farms, and Wright Farms.

RULES AND INFORMATION

1. Replacement exhibitors must be 4-H or FFA members within Gasconade County and at least 8 years old as of January 1st of the current year.
2. Exhibitors can register two replacement heifers, but only show and sell one.
3. Replacement heifers must be born between January 1st and December 31st of 2025.
4. Replacement heifers will be shown by birth date.
5. No horns or scurs allowed. Must be polled or dehorned and completely healed prior to the fair.
6. Must be vaccinated for IBR, BVD, PI3, BRSV, Lepto (5-Way), Vibriosis, 7-Way Clostridia.
7. Must be treated for internal and external parasites within 30 days of the fair.
8. Must present a CVI form from a veterinarian with information regarding health status, required vaccinations, and parasite control, along with pregnancy status, pelvic measurements, and reproductive tract score if over 1 year of age by the Fair. Must have an EID tag.
9. Entry submission is required for replacement heifers and are due July 1st. See entries details.
10. Exhibitors can show market animals of other species as well, they will be allowed to sell one market animal and one replacement heifer, then the exhibitor will collect all the proceeds of their market animal along with 80% of the replacement heifer proceeds and 20% of the proceeds will go back to the livestock committee for improvements.

11. Replacement heifers will sell last in the livestock sale auction. Sale order will be determined by class placing.
12. The replacement heifer show will be held on Thursday evening, at 6:30 p.m.

1. This show is designed for youth 5-7 years of age. Classes will be broken down by age of exhibitor.
2. All calves must have been born from April 1, 2025 to June 1, 2025.
3. Calves may be dairy, beef or cross heifers, steers or bulls.
4. Calves shown as bucket calves may not be shown in other Gasconade County Fair Livestock Classes.
5. Bucket calves will NOT be allowed to sell in the Livestock Sale.
6. All calves must be checked in by 9:30 a.m., Thursday. Check-in at show arena.
7. Calves will be released at 8:00 p.m., July 24, 2025.
8. Exhibitors are limited to one entry per class.
9. This show is open to other counties.
10. Entry fees of \$4.00 per head.

4-H BUCKET CALF SHOW THURSDAY TO BE JUDGED AT 10:00 A.M. Show Arena

1. Exhibitors must be enrolled in a 4-H Bucket Calf Project.
2. This project is designed for youth 8-12 years of age.
3. All calves must have been born from January 1 to June 1 of the current year.
4. Calves may be dairy, beef or cross-bred heifers, steers or bulls.
5. Calves shown as bucket calves may not be shown in other Gasconade County Fair Livestock classes.
6. Bucket calves will NOT be allowed to sell in the Livestock Sale.
7. **Classes** will be divided by ages of exhibitors.
8. All calves must be checked in by 9:00 a.m., Thursday of the fair. **Check-in to be in Show Arena**
9. Calves will be released at 8:00 p.m., on the day of the show.
10. Exhibitors are limited to two entries per class.
11. This show is open to other counties.
12. The following criteria will be used for judging the Bucket Calf classes:
 - (100 points possible)
 - 25 points - Presentation of the calf in the show ring
 - 20 points - Condition and health of calf
 - 5 points - Quality of the calf

50 points - Member's knowledge of the calf (age, breed); feeding (amount, cost, what, and when, how much); care of the calf given by the member; interview with the judge to determine member's knowledge.

13. Premiums will be mailed to the 4-H Club after the County Fair.
14. Entry fees of \$4.00/head.
15. All bucket calves must be in compliance with the rules specified by the "ANIMAL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR EXHIBITION/MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.
16. All beef require an active CVI form for the duration of the fair and an EID as stated in the General Livestock Rules.

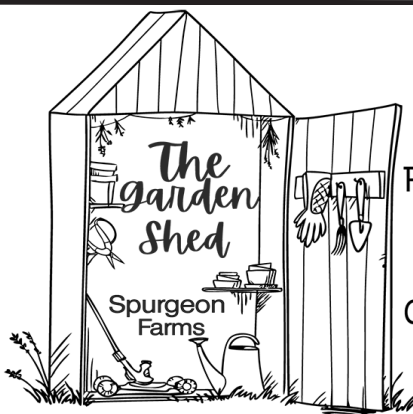
